

January 11, 1978 (Wednesday)

Relief Society. The children were very good. I couldn't hear them and my voice was starting to crack. When I arrived home I received a call from Jane telling me to pick her up. She was also ill. It rained most of day.

January 12, 1978 (Thursday)

Jane spent the morning helping me. She didn't feel good enough to go to school but good enough to do odd jobs around the house. It rained most of the day.

January 13, 1978 (Friday)

A sunshiny day at last - so good I got some more walking in. Ruderger and I walked to the office and then I walked back home. We enjoyed it so much. Ruderger went to the Dr. today and found he had lost 20 lbs. so far and his blood pressure is very normal. He said that of a 25 year old.

January 14, 1978 (Saturday)

We spent this day as usual on Saturday, running errands, marketing and just goofing and that usually means spending too much money. I hung some curtains but Ruderger said they had to come down because they were not warm enough. Oh well, they were some he salvaged at the office. They looked like they should have been in a museum.

January 15, 1978 (Sunday)

More of the rain today and wind you wouldn't believe but we all made it to church. We also attended meeting in the 13th ward where Scott was the speaker.

January 16, 1978 (Monday)

Whenever I attend a funeral I realize the importance of writing my journal.

Malen Cox, our good neighbor in Pine Valley, was buried today in Pine Valley. Ruderger sang. I'll always remember Malen for his very humorous stories. He always had one for us. Wish I could have known him as a kid. He sounds like a man that was a friend to everyone.

It is raining again today. If we didn't need the moisture I would say, "Go away, come again another day."

January 17, 1978 (Tuesday)

Received a call from Ruderger inviting me to ride to Gunlock with him to see if the water level was improving and it was after the rain all night and a good snowpack on the mountain. Ruderger went to Bess Benson's graveside service. She is a relative on McAllister line and a very good friend of Aunt Orpha's. Ruderger and I went to Dick's for lunch and it was delightful. Made pies that are against our diets so Scott took them to the girls at the dorm. He knew what he was doing because they invited him to lunch the next day. He gives them the old song and dance deal where he hasn't eaten all day and they actually fall for his line.

January 18, 1978 (Wednesday)

Relief Society. I started at 7:30 a.m. to get a casserole made to take to Lee Bland's funeral. Relief Society was great. I have become attached to the kids in my class this year. They all love me I know. We took a ride to Pine Valley to see how much snow. Not much in the valley, lots on the mountain.

January 19, 1978 (Thursday)

I jumped right out of bed this morning. I knew if we were to go to Salt Lake City tomorrow, I had plenty to do. Jane invited a friend to stay the night. I had to say no and that didn't go over too good and Scott invited a girl to breakfast because he knew we would be gone. The mean mother that I am but they just can't do that to me. I just said no, no, no. Rudger could have said it once and they would know he meant it. Oh well, chances are they still like me.

January 20 1978 (Friday)

We were so looking forward to this trip to Salt Lake City but the weather isn't the best and so have to get back tomorrow, disappointing. Visited with Jackie's family. Everyone was so happy. The kids showed us their Christmas gifts and Jennifer opened the birthday gift we brought to her. George had just returned from Hawaii and we ate fresh pineapple.

January 21, 1978 (Saturday)

What a great morning, in bed til 10 a.m., leisure breakfast and then hit the road. It rained all the way home. Jane and Scott did not please me, however, nothing done. That made for a bad mood. I had better learn to control my feelings. All made up and kissed better and went to bed happy.

January 22, 1978 (Sunday)

Have a bad cold, stayed home all day long. Scott sang in one ward and talked in another. I wanted so much to go hear him.

January 23 1978 (Monday)

Jennifer's birthday. I cannot hear good so that makes for an unhappy family. Glad when the cold will be over.

January 24, 1978 (Tuesday)

Lucky enough to have the kind of cold that doesn't make you feel too bad just bad enough to keep me in the house and not working. I watched TV all day. How lazy can I get?

January 25, 1978 (Wednesday)

I didn't go to Relief Society today. I did go for a walk and felt much better for it.

January 26, 1978 (Thursday)

Still a day without getting any work done. Imagine what the house must look like. Oh, Well. Rudger says, "big deal", so I don't worry about it.

January 27, 1978 (Friday)

Wow! Today I feel like turning the world over. I scrubbed floors cleaned out closets and drawers, walked to meet Rudger. Scott performed with Laura Grishm at 4 Seasons. He seemed satisfied with the way it went.

January 28, 1978 (Saturday)

I made the mistake of going outside. Rudger put me to work pulling weeds and shoveling dirt. I didn't see the inside of the house again until 3 o'clock. We rode to Gunlock. Scott came home about 9 p.m. with 2 girls that brought us a pie - was it ever good.

January 29, 1978 (Sunday)

Laura and Scott practiced here most of day. We had Mr. and Mrs. McCleary visit -home teachers. They are always interesting to hear and talk to.

January 30, 1978 (Monday)

Took a casserole up to Judd's. Lou died. She was 100 years old. We went to the funeral. When we got home Bill and Ruth were here. We caught up on a little genealogy and just had a very good visit. It was about 60 degrees and a lovely day.

February 1, 1978 (Wednesday)

We took Bill and Ruth out for a drive and visited some more. We all agreed that we should get together more often and tell more stories of the past and get them written down.

February 2, 1978 (Thursday)

I drove the new Aspen wagon today. Lunt's brought it up for me to try. I went shopping and walked to Lin's and Rachel Judd picked me up and brought me home. Walked to meet Jane, indulged in a fattening milk shake and bought 2 pair new shoes.

February 3 1978 (Friday)

Jane had no school today and we made brownies, washed our hair, made arrangements to buy the Aspen wagon. It is going to be fun. I love the car We traded in our GMC truck for it.

February 4, 1978 (Saturday)

It was cold and a little windy today so we didn't get our fence started like we thought we could In the evening we called on Kay and Enid.

February 5 1978 (Sunday)

We all attended church meetings but stayed in the rest of the day. It was raining again. We needed the rain, we prayed for the rain and we are getting it but now I wish it could shine for just a second.

February 6, 1978 (Monday)

What a wet Monday. I walked to town with my trusty umbrella. We cut up the banana squash we raised in Pine Valley. It was so good, took some to Enid and Lillian and Scott's friends at the dorm.

February 7, 1978 (Tuesday)

We attended Owen Wright's funeral. It was a pleasant day but a little windy. We needed coats and that is different for Dixie.

February 8, 1978 (Wednesday)

It rained all night and all day. I went shopping in my new little car I love that car. Went to Vicky's for a wall decoration show. It was interesting. I purchased a picture.

February 9, 1978 (Thursday)

I hurried to the market to get the good sale items of the week, Tide 10 lbs \$3.99; toilet tissue \$16.00 a case. But, where now do I store it. I cleaned out a closet, stacked it in there. Some

things have got to go. It is really raining today. When I picked Jane up, a regular traffic jam at the school.

February 10, 1978 (Friday)

Rained again all night and day. We rode to Gunlock. The water was too high. The golf course was being threatened. Ruderger went to see the Dr. and had lost four more pounds. I made spiced nuts for him to give to Dr. Booth and staff. We went to Dick's for lunch, was a fun day. Scott did foul things up. He put my car keys in his pocket and went to work and so Jane walked home from school in the rain.

February 11, 1978 (Saturday)

Went to Gunlock and to the market and met a lot of friends there. Jewell and Enid both came in while we were there. In the afternoon we went to Snow Canyon and walked up one of the smaller canyons. We picked up some nice mossy rocks to put in our front lawn. We took Kay and Enid for a ride in our new car. Scott is working at the motel tonight.

February 12, 1978 (Sunday)

It turned out a little cold last night and today. I cannot get used to it after such good weather. Attended meetings and stayed in the rest of day.

February 13 1978 (Monday)

Kind of another chilly, rainy day. We worked outside putting in a drainpipe. Ruderger had the day off. It started to rain hard and so we went for a ride.

February 14, 1978 (Tuesday)

Received a call from Viola. She is coming to stay with me. I cannot believe it. Richard and Ellen will be here too. Ruderger and I planned on flying to Salt Lake but the plane was full. Best for me because i will have to get the house ready for guests.

February 15, 1978 (Wednesday)

Relief Society turned out OK. The children gave me a hassle. I had to be mean to them and it made me sad. The weather was so nice, getting spring like. I love it, love it. Washed out the driveway and watered tulips that are coming up.

February 16, 1978 (Thursday)

Hurried to get ready for the guests. Scott's bedroom for Richard, Ellen and Ryan, my room for Viola and Jane's for us. That's the way it will have to be. Made a cherry cheesecake and a casserole and spaghetti sauce. All turned out good. Richard and Ellen arrived late.

February 17, 1978 (Friday)

Viola came about noon. Ryan stayed with us while Richard and Ellen went to Cedar City. We took everyone to Dick's for dinner. It was a great time.

February 18, 1978 (Saturday)

Viola and I went to Dick's for breakfast. It was such a nice morning. This evening Viola and I attended the musical, "No, No, Nanette." We both enjoyed it so much.

February 19, 1978 (Sunday)

Viola left at noon. I hurried dinner so she could eat with us before she left. We had a very good visit. Was so glad she could come. The rest of us all went to Sacramento meeting. Scott brought a girl friend home and she and Ellen made cream puffs and we all watched TV.

February 20 1978 (Monday)

Presidents Day. We all stayed home today. We were all sad when Richard, Ellen and Ryan packed up and left. We went to Pine Valley for a cultivator.

February 21, 1978 (Tuesday)

Planted some of our garden today. Peas, carrots and beets and go the rows ready for everything else. It was fun. 70° Wow!. Love it.

February 22, 1978 (Wednesday)

George's birthday - sent him a book. Had a very good time at Relief Society. Washed the car. I love that car. Paid some bills. Walked to meet Jane. Cleaned a closet. Rudge keeps asking if I have seen any seeds sprouting yet. Oh, boy.

February 23, 1978 (Thursday)

It is raining again. Received a letter from Ruth and Bill. They sent me Daddy's life history that he wrote for them just before he died. I was so happy with it.

February 24, 1978 (Friday)

Sun shining. I think it rains so much lately that I cannot keep track.

February 25, 1978 (Saturday)

We put up the fence today. Jody Fullerton send over some cookies. They were good.

February 26, 1978 (Sunday)

Can't hear so good today. Went for a ride down to Cedar Pockets to check gas mileage.

February 27, 19978 (Monday)

I don't like days like this. Something is settling in them thar ears. I can't hear much.

February 28, 1978 (Tuesday)

My ears are aching like you wouldn't believe. Wionder what is wrong.

March 1, 1978 (Wednesday)

Joey's birthday - almost forgot to call her. Sounded like she was having a nomal birthday. Russell's mother invited them to birthday dinner. It rained all day. I am having a bad earache in the other ear tonight. It is really bad. If I didn't have a pain pill I would really be suffering. I am losing all of my hearing, never has been so bad before, so very frightening.

March 2, 1978 (Thursday)

Rain, Rain go away again. I am looking for sunshine to cheer me up. I need something.

March 3, 1978 (Friday)

The Gunlock Dam spilled today causing lots of damage. The Lava Hills Golf course was flooded and the bridge washed out near Green Valley. I still cannot hear one thing, not even on the telephone.

March 4, 1978 (Saturday)

Still raining this morning. We rode to Gunlock but didn't get out of the car. Ruderger and Scott sang at conference tonight.

March 5, 1978 (Sunday)

Stake Conference - made a new stake, St. George West, which is us. Gives us a new bishopric, John Palmer, Allen Carter and McCleary. Rode to Gunlock with Scott and his friend, Dayna Gentry. We walked across the dam, watched the dam spill.

March 6, 1978 (Monday)

Sun is out. Love it. But I cannot go out because I cannot hear.

March 7, 1978 (Tuesday)

More sunshine and we need it to help dry things out. The blossoms are out and so pretty. Kind of late, I would say. Spring is here now and we are ready.

March 8, 1978 (Wednesday)

Couldn't go to Relief Society again. Ruderger took me to see a Dr. Wyler and he said I have really high blood pressure, probably because of infection. Have to take lots of pills. Hope it clears up on the hearing. Scott had a barbeque in the back yard., a bachelor party for Wayne (Stucki). It turned out nice.

March 9, 1978 (Thursday)

Nice sunshiny day. Don't have much energy. Can't hear but still hangin in there.

March 10, 1978 (Friday)

It was a nice day until time for Jane to come home then it rained like everything. Scott said it wouldn't hurt her to walk in the rain because Abraham Lincoln walked in the rain. Scott really cheers me up. He doesn't seem to mind talking to me (I should say shouting at me) when I can't hear. We still have good conversations. No one else is much interested. Today Scott even sent me a plant to cheer me up.

March 11, 1978 (Saturday)

Old age is having too much room in the house and not much room in the medicine cabinet. Is that ever true with me right now. I am taking so many pills. I am worried. Still cannot hear a thing. My ears are popping right along so still have hope. Ruderger came home and decided he needed some home cookin and so he went to Kentucky Fried Chicken place. Jane went babysitting. Scott went to this friend, Dayna, where else? It rained all day long.

March 12, 1978 (Sunday)

Rudger took me for a ride. This staying home all the time is getting to me.

March 13, 1978 (Monday)

Hey! My hearing came back a little today. I was really beginning to wonder. Scott is getting ready for finals and so we had him home for tonight. Whoops! There he went - had a party to go to. Thought it was too good to be true. I helped Jane with her science project.

March 14, 1978 (Tuesday)

Rudger came home and we spent a little time just looking at our garden. The peas are up at least 2 inches. I am getting so excited about the garden now.

March 15, 1978 (Wednesday)

What a way to wake up. Scott invited some kids to breakfast at 7:00, girls and boys. They did it themselves, waffles, strawberries and ice cream. How fattening and good they smelled. Then they left, I got up and none of that good smell was left, cleaned up to the last crumb. Rudger flew to Salt Lake City at 9:30 a.m. Jane's coal garden for science grew too much to last so we made another one. Glad that is over for another year.

March 16, 1978 (Thursday)

Went for a visit to the doctor and my blood pressure had gone down and I can hear a little better. He changed all my medication and I go back again in 8 days.

March 17, 1978 (Friday)

Worked outside. Did me a lot of good. I decided I couldn't stay home forever so went marketing and to buy wedding gifts. Wayne Stucki and Fran Esplin were married today. Scott was best man and it was a gorgeous wedding. The weather was very warm today.

March 18, 1978 (Saturday)

Did a little visiting around the neighborhood. Hap and Roma were down cleaning their yard. I went with Rudger to several stores looking for fittings for sprinkling system. Scott flew to California at 6:00 a.m. Bruce Stucki flew him down so he could join the chamber choir at Disney.

March 19, 1978 (Sunday)

Rudger and Jane went to their meetings. I still cannot hear well enough to go. Rudger took me for a long ride down in the fields and to Bloomington.

March 20, 1978 (Monday)

Jane came home on the bus and in a very good mood for a change. We got a lot of work caught up. Called Ellen and they are great but are not coming home for Easter.

March 21, 1978 (Tuesday)

Feel much better today. It is cloudy. Hope it doesn't rain.

March 22, 1978 (Wednesday)

Jackie and family are all coming for Easter. It is going to be fun.

March 23, 1978 (Thursday)

We spent a lot of time on the patio. This is a fun time of the year.

March 1, 1978 (Friday)

We opened the window and doors and let the sunshine in. Scott hinted around again today about August being the date. He probably has already popped the question. He didn't ask me.

May 11, 1978 (Thursday)

A lot of talk about Mothers Day coming up. What do I want (the mother who has everything) as Jackie puts it. I would like candy but that is fattening. I'll mention it anyway.

May 12 1978 (Friday)

We went to the Gable House with the Arlidges. It was a super good time and the food was so good.

May 13, 1978 (Saturday)

Just worked today, accomplished a lot. Packed up our cleaning gear and headed for Pine Valley.

May 14 1978 (Sunday)

It is Mothers Day. The kids all called and Jackie sent a real nice gift for my new bathroom. A ceramic swan that holds washcloths. Scott, Jane and Rudger came thru with some candy. Wow! What a super day. We went to Pine Valley, made a fire in the fireplace and just relaxed and reminisced. My children are so special. I know they love me.

May 14, 1978 (Monday)

I made a couple of casseroles and went shopping. Returned a dress I bought for Jane. We picked peas from the garden. Bill called and said they would be down to stay with us. They were invited to a wedding on our St. George Temple.

May 15, 1978 (Tuesday)

Bill and Ruth arrived about 3:30. We sure had a good visit with them. Rudger flew to SLC and arrived home just in time to eat dinner with us. We called Ken and Mary and all of us talked to them.

May 16, 1978 (Wednesday)

Didn't get up very early because everyone were up and gone before 6:30 a.m. Scott went on a field trip. He came back so tired but his performance had to go on. Ruth and Bill left about 4:30 p.m. Rudger came home with a bit of hay fever and stayed in bed all afternoon.

May 17 1978 (Thrusday)

Mowed lawns. I visited over the fence with Debbie Childers and Vicky Wyle. I must be getting old. Their kids drove me up a wall. So I came in the house.

Missed Aril so here it is:**April 1, 1978 (Saturday)**

Rode to Pine Valley to get our dutch ovens. Nice day.

April 2, 1978 (Sunday)

Was General Conference so all of us listened to it on TV. We rode to Gunlock. The conference talks were very good. Jane made a cake. We ate the icing.

April 3, 1978 (Monday)

One of those days. Just the usual things like laundry.

April 4, 1978 (Tuesday)

Oiled up the lawnmower and to my surprise it is running good.

April 5, 1978 (Wednesday)

Don't feel good again today. This staying in bed all day is not for me.

April 6, 1978 (Thursday)

Went to see Dr. Wyler. He changed my medication again. Still cannot hear. I am not going to him again.

April 7, 1978 (Friday)

We took off for Salt Lake but it was snowing when we got as far as Leeds and so we turned around and came home. We then tried to get reservations in Vegas but couldn't so we went to Zion Park and Driftwood and spent a nice day and had a nice dinner.

April 8, 1978 (Saturday)

Awakened to the sound of water. Lillian's irrigation water coming into our yard soaked in good and into the basement. We bailed out water all day and into the night. I am mad! mad! mad! but I will forgive and forget some day.

April 9, 1978 (Sunday)

Stiff and sore from yesterday. Still cannot hear so stayed home and rested.

April 10, 1978 (Monday)

We have been having very nice weather. The odor is just about out of the basement now so I must put everything back. Scott brought Dayna up to visit tonight. I have finally made up my mind or accepted the idea that Scott is getting married.

April 11, 1978 (Tuesday)

Scott is clipping the hedges and getting quite professional, and I really thought Richard was best. Scott gave Dayna her ring today so they are engaged.

April 12, 1978 (Wednesday)

Ruth and Rulen visited. I was ill. Ruderger took me to the emergency room at hospital at midnight. I was allergic to the medication I took.

April 13, 1978 (Thursday)

We are in Salt Lake City, The motel is so nice. Saw Lorin and LaVina. Went shopping at the mall. I thought LaVina would be a lot better but she isn't. Wish I had the courage to tell her what I think. Couldn't find Jane a dress so bought something for myself.

Joey is having surgery today. She called and said she had been so sick I guess she nearly died. Oh how I wish we were closer. I worry so much about her.

April 14, 1978 (Friday)

We are still in Salt Lake City. It seems so good to be away. Can't hear. I just lay here in a motel room and watch T.V., go to meals and walk a little. That's it.

April 15, 1978 (Saturday)

I thought I would go for this kind of life but it's not for me. Rudger is content to just lounging but I keep taking walks. I have to get out and go.

April 16 1978 (Sunday)

some more of the same kind of life - getting up when we wanted to - no hurry.

April 17, 1978 (Monday)

Dr. Zobell gave me the once over. It is not an infection like Wyler was treating it for so now back to different medication and time and something I must live with - allergies. We got back in St. George at 9:00 p.m. and darn glad to be home. But I guess I have to consider me and my social life lost for another few weeks.

April 18, 1978 (Tuesday)

Really felt good today but am tired tonight. Jane didn't get to MIA so we can go to bed early.

April 19, 1978 (Wednesday)

I was just plain sick, nauseous, must be the medication Dr. Zobell prescribed. I couldn't even raise my head.

April 20, 1978 (Thursday)

Rudger called Dr. Staheli and he told me to stop the pills at least until I feel better. Scott brought Dayna up and we all had water mellon. That is what I needed for my poor old tummy.

April 21, 1978 (Friday)

Made a cake and even ate some of it. Rudger went to a cookout retirement party for Lewis Pectol and he brought some steak and food to Jane and I. It tasted so good.

April 22, 1978 (Saturday)

We worked outside. Rudger weeded and I mowed lawns and finished up the hedges. Excuse me, I meant Scott finished the hedges. We are tired but that makes for good sleeping.

April 23, 1978 (Sunday)

I still cannot go to church. I am getting my hearing back but not that much. After church Rudger went to Clesson Bowers for an open house honoring Bishop Stucki. We rode to Pine Valley and cracked a few nuts.

April 24, 1978 (Monday)

Just a Monday, hardly worth writing about.

April 25, 1978 (Monday)

Jane went to Santa Clara to an arts festival.

April 26, 1978 (Wednesday)

I spent from 8:30 to 2:00 at the clinic. They drew blood from me every hour and got plenty of it. Hope all does some good. I had to fast all that time and fasting is hard for me.

April 27, 1978 (Thursday)

I copied a lot of recipes today, got my recipe file up to date and of course was waiting for that all important call to see if I have sugar diabetes. He finally called and said I was OK. Hurrah. I am so happy.

April 28, 1978 (Friday)

Jane went to the track meet today. She didn't come home and was I ever frantic. She did finally show up about 6 p.m. with Lori Wattier and her mother. She had been having fun and she couldn't call so I guess I'll forgive and forget. I went to Ben Wyly's birthday party. Picked out Scott a new suit for his birthday. Mr. McClary came home teaching. He is in the bishopric now.

April 29, 1978 (Saturday)

Rudger went to Pine Valley to get the chapel ready for an institute party. He put the water in the house ready for the summer. We went to the D-Day Dance tonight. Sat by Ruth Snow and Clark and Ora Lee (McMullin). Seemed like good old times again. Governor Matheson was the honored speaker.

April 30, 1978 (Sunday)

They held a special fast for the Blake boy. We had dinner at 3:00. That makes for a long morning. We drove up to Ivins town to see the new chapel and firehouse and there are lots of new houses. It has really built up a lot since I was up last.

May 1, 1978 (Monday)

I hurried with my work because we went to Cedar. We gathered up Scot and Dayna and Jane and met Richard, Ellen and Ryan (They came down for a school meet from Moab.) We all had dinner at Town and Country. It was simply elegant besides enjoying a good visit with those kids. They met Dayna for 1st tim and we ate too much as usual. It was a rainy day and trip.

May 2, 1978 (Tuesday)

Another rainy day so didn't get outside.

May 3, 1978 (Wednesday)

Stayed home all day. Rudger had a meeting.

May 4, 1978 (Thursday)

Rudger went with some fellows to dinner at the Gable House. Scott and Dayna sang at a wedding and ushered at a concert. Jane went to help serve at the ward dinner and I stayed home alone. Jane did surprise me and brought dinner to me and it was yummy.

May 5, 1978 (Friday)

Jane and I went shopping then seh went bab sitting I made a pie and sent it o Clark and ora Lee. Her father, Rex Gardner, died. Rudger went to his funeral with Enid. I just didn't feel up to par. Jane was late so I watched TV and waited up.

May 6, 1978 (Saturday)

Made cookies to sent to Jackie and for Scott and Dayna's lunch. they are on their way to SLC to find housing and a job.

May 7, 1978 (Sunday)

Another rainy, blowing day and cold. Karen and Mike had a baby girl this morning.

May 8, 1978 (Monday)

Rudger went to Rotary so I worked right thru lunch. We worked outside in afternoon, had a good visit with Lillian. She gave us strawberries out of her garden. Scott and Dayna made it back from SLC. Had fun but not any luck.

May 9, 1978 (Tuesday)

Scot's birthday. Had a haircut. Scott had a very happy day with many friends remembering the occasion Dayna took him to Paula's for dinner and then home for cake and ice cream.

May 10, 1978 (Wednesday)

Jane came home from school with a hurt and so I took her to the Dr. She had put something out of place jumping on the trampoline. (shoulder)

May 18, 1978 (Friday)

The house is beginning to show neglect. I didn't do anything again today. We even went to Dick's for lunch.

May 19, 1978 (Saturday)

Jane and I went shopping. We purchased some lawn chair, redwood type, watched a little TV tonight.

May 20, 1978 (Sunday)

Kay and Enid came for a visit and Scott brought Dayna up.

May 21, 1978 (Monday)

Rudger went to Rotary so I put up the drapes in our bedroom, picked Jane up and took her to piano.

May 22, 1978 (Tuesday)

September 25, 1978 (Monday)

Attended a Relief Society meeting at the chapel. Rudger and I went to Whetto Roblez funeral then we went to Pine Valley. It was so nice up there - loved it.

September 26, 1978 (Tuesday)

Cannot say I did anything worth writing about. Just took Jane to school and picked her up.

September 27, 1978 (Wednesday)

Went to Relief Society. They had a very good lunch. Did some walking. Went to see Don's and Vicky's new house at Bloomington Hills. Bought Jane a pretty dress.

September 29, 1978 (Friday)

Brought apples in from dryer, got them ready for storage. Jane and I went to the Movie. Wasn't much good.

September 30, 1978 (Saturday)

Spent nearly all day at Athella's garage sale. We had fun visiting, if nothing else. Some neighbors bought stuff from me but didn't pay so I didn't do so good.

October 1, 1978 (Sunday)

General Conference today. We listened on TV and on the radio on the way to Pine Valley. Could have stayed all day but hurried back to Sacrament Meeting at 4 p.m.

October 2, 1978 (Monday)

October 10, 1978 (Tuesday)

October 11, 1978 (Wednesday)

Relief Society. Read stories to the children. It was alright. Had lunch there, attended a meeting after. A lot of good information. Picked Jane up from school. Took her to piano lesson. Went for a walk and real tired now.

October 12, 1978 (Thursday)

Jane had a sore throat. Started her on the penicillin. It really has been a nice day.

October 13, 1978 (Friday)

Shopping, housework, the usual.

October 14, 1978 (Saturday)

Rudger and I got an early start. We went to Kiabab Forrest for some wood. What a great time we had - not much wood but fun. Went to Pitchforths for a housewarming. It was nice and their new house is so beautiful.

October 15, 1978- (Sunday)

Went to Pine Valley, saw a lot of deer. Does and fawns. They seemed so very tame.

October 16, 1978 (Monday)

We unladed the wood we brought down Saturday.

October 17, 1978 (Tuesday)

Went out to get some more wood. This time we knew where to look and what to look for and got a good load. Came back early.

October 18, 1978 (Wednesday)

Rudger and I went to Cedar City.

October 19, 1978 (Thursday)

Rudger's birthday.

October 20, 1978 (Friday)

Went for more wood.

October 21, 1978 (Saturday)

Went to Cedar to buy clogs for Jane. Went over the mountain to P.V.

October 31, 1978 (Tuesday)

Rode to Kanab with Rudger. It was a quick trip but we had a good visit.

November 1, 1978 (Wednesday)

Relief Society and meetings all day.

November 2, 1978 (Thursday)

Went to Enid's and helped her with a quilt for Gordon and Julie.

November 3, 1978 (Friday)

Jackie's birthday. I decided to clean the china cabinet today and that I did - looks beautiful.

November 4, 1978 (Saturday)

We loaded mattresses and a 10 speed bike in our trusty truck and Rudger, Jane and I took off for Provo to deliver them to Scott. They had a great dinner for us. We stayed at the Holiday Inn.

November 5, 1978 (Sunday)

Got up early and started home. Arrived at 1 p.m. and went to Sacramento.

November 6, 1978 (Monday)

Nov and December, 1978, a very busy time. Didn't get to write in my journal. Rudger, Jane and I had Thanksgiving at home alone. The kids all had other commitments or didn't want to make the long journey. We had the usual, hurrying to buy Christmas gifts for everyone. Our tree we selected was green with red and white ornaments, red ribbons. Scott and Dayna were here for a couple of days to make it a memorable occasion. We attended 3 parties between Christmas and New Year's, went to the Gable House with one group for New Years Eve then down to Ronald's and Lorna's after for fun and games.
