My dear son, Wilford Woodruff McArthur, having authority given me of Jesus Christ, I lay my hands upon your head and seal upon you a patriarchal blessing. Your lineage is of the house of Jacob through the loins of Ephraim and you are lawful heir to all the blessings of the new and everlasting covenant both in heaven and on earth and your calling is to preach the everlasting gospel to the inhabitants of the earth wherever you will be sent by the servants of the living God. Now, I say unto you that not one word of this blessing shall fail you if you are faithful and true to the end and I seal you up unto eternal life.
